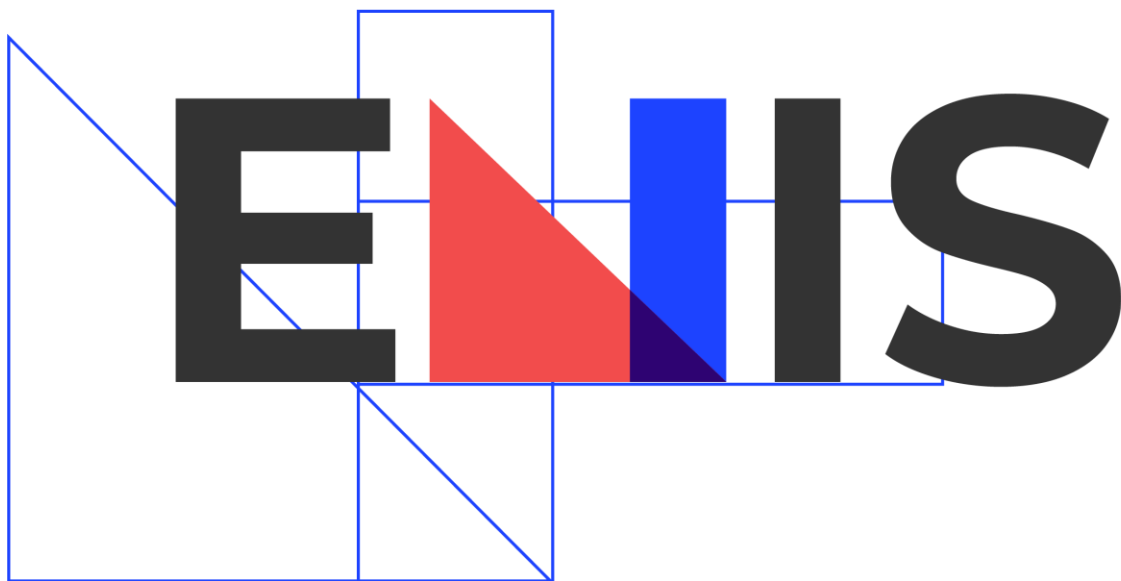
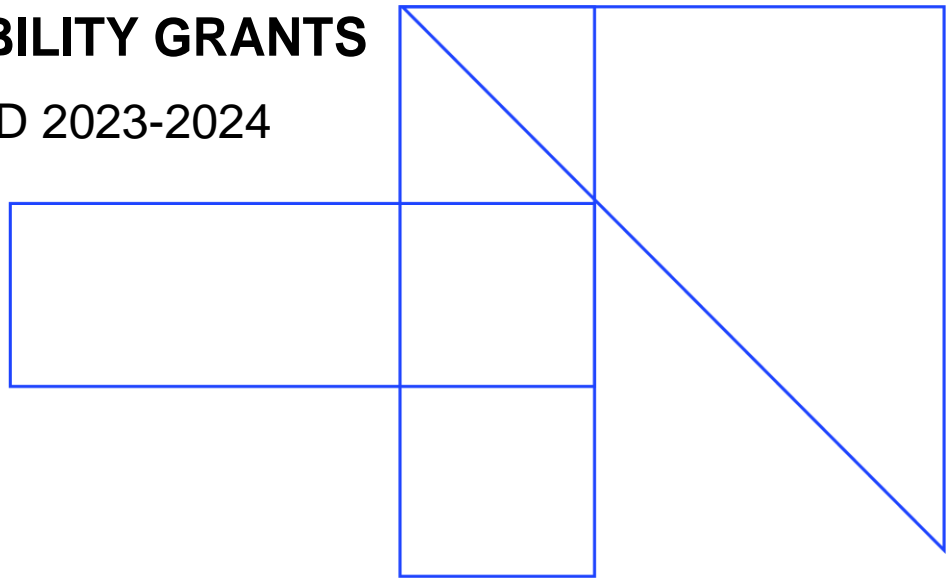

VIRTUAL MOBILITY GRANT - GRANT PERIOD 2023-2024

ENIS COST Action "European Network on International Student Mobility: Connecting Research and Practice" is happy to announce the opening of the call for applications for Virtual Mobility Grants - Grant year 2023/2024.

Scope:

Virtual Mobility (VM) grant consists of collaboration in a virtual setting among researchers or innovators within the COST Action, contributing to the development of the Action and fostering collaboration between members.

Content and focus:

Applications should aim towards the production of a joint publication, such as special issues in Q1 journals or edited book volumes in renowned publishing houses (e.g., Routledge, Palgrave) related to the field of ISM. These publications should gather contributions from a minimum of three ENIS members.

Number of grants available:

Four (4)

Financial Support:

500 euros per application.

Eligibility:

The application must be supported by:

- a letter from the WG leader
- a letter from the participants in the collaborative initiative.

Duration:

- Minimum of 12 collaborative working hours.

Evaluation Criteria

- Alignment of the goals of the VM to the Action's objective (2 points)
- Expected impact on the Action development (2 points)
- Sustainability of the cooperation (1 point).

Priorities:

Young researchers and innovators (< 40 years old);
Researchers from inclusiveness target country (ITC);
Gender balance will be taken into account.

Period:

Collaboration sessions should take place between 1 May and 30 September 2024.

Timeline:

- Open of call: **March 20, 2024**
 - Deadline for application: **April 20, 2024**
- Decision process and announcements of results: Up to a month after the close of the call.

How to apply?

- A. Fill in the Virtual Mobility application form (template available on e-COST).
- B. Fill in the e-COST form (<https://e-services.cost.eu/>)
- C. Uploaded to the e-COST system:
 - Application form;
 - Support letter from WG leader
 - Support letter from the participants in the collaborative initiative
 - A proposal draft outlining the publication's objectives, specifying its scope, identifying the intended journal or publishing venue, listing the authors, and planning a timeline for completion.
- D. Clearly state in your CV if you are a young innovator (< 40 years old) and if you hold a tenure position.

Reporting and claim for payment of the grant

Upon the conclusion of the conference, within 30 days after the end of the activity, the grantees have to submit via the e-COST system:

- The claim for the payment of the grant is made via the e-COST system;
- Report to the Action MC on the main achievements of the Virtual Mobility and planned future follow-up activities.
- A final proposal document encompassing:
 - The rationale and relevance of the proposal,
 - Conceptual and methodological framework,
 - A detailed timeline outlining the sequential steps for submission
 - Title of the contributions to feature in the proposal
 - Key references supporting the proposal.

Obligations:

Grantees and host researchers commit to writing a post and sending pictures of the VM for the social media network.

Clarifications:

The COST Association and the Grant Holder of the Action cannot be considered as grantee's employer. Grantees must make arrangements for all provisions related to personal security, health, taxation, social security, and pension matters.
